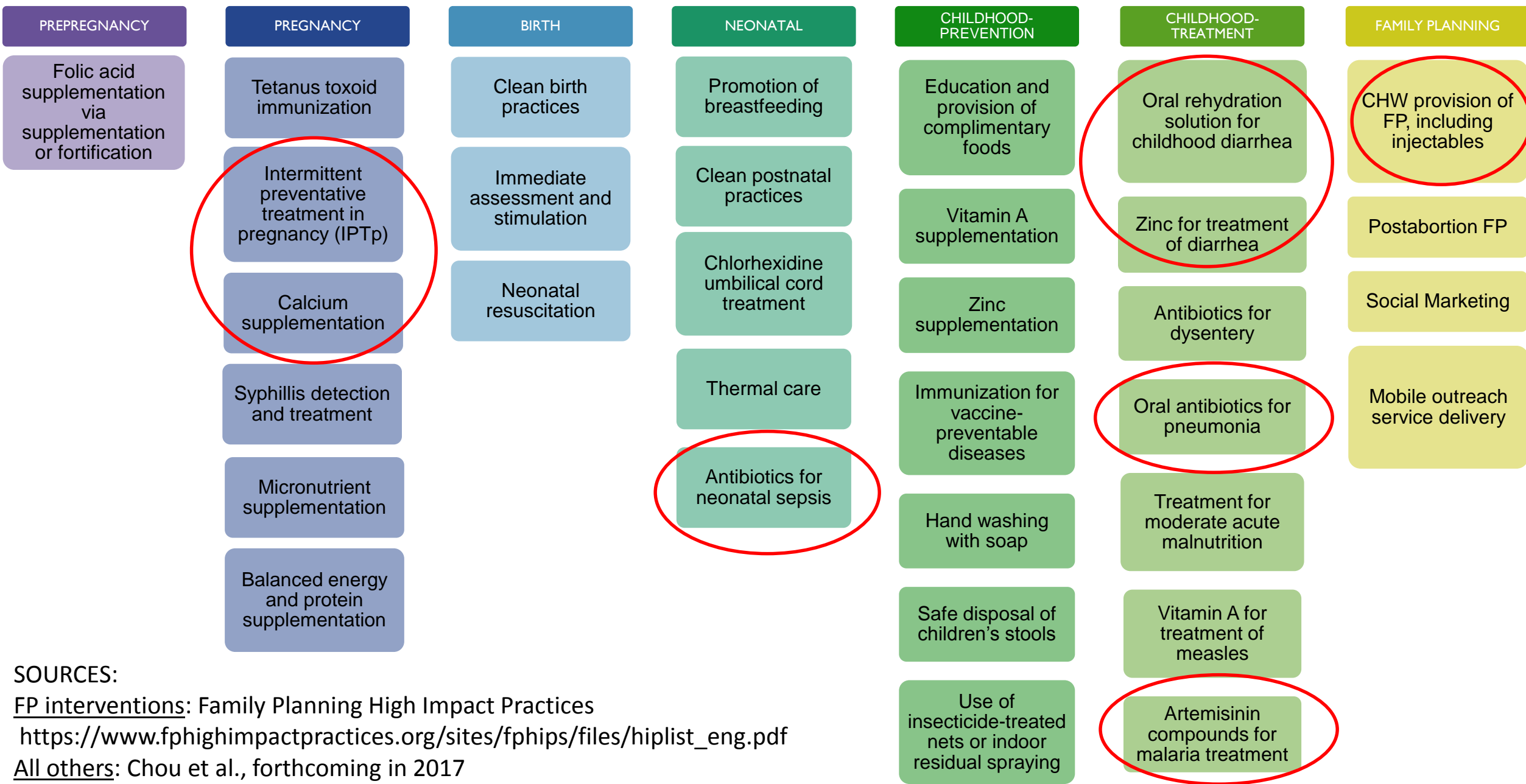

Topics for Knowledge Café

- Newborn Health: WHO recommendations on treatment of Possibly Serious Bacterial Infections (PSBI)
- Child Health: Integrated Community Case Management (iCCM)
- Maternal Health: CB IPT_p, calcium distribution for pre-eclampsia prevention, first dose of MgSO₄ for eclampsia
- Family Planning: Community-based delivery of injectable contraceptives

Knowledge café

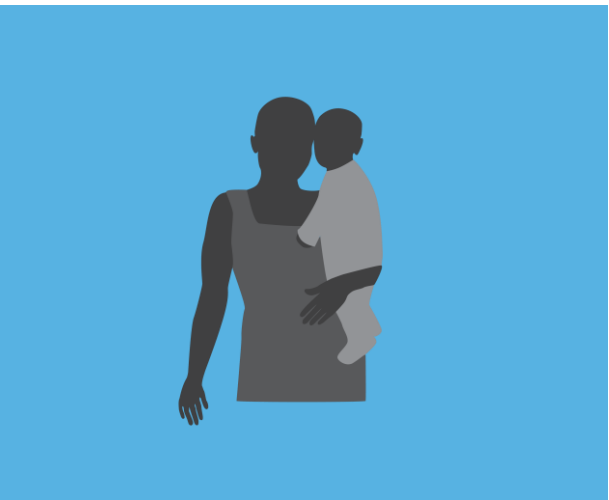
- Facilitator will give a brief presentation to summarize (15-20 mins)
